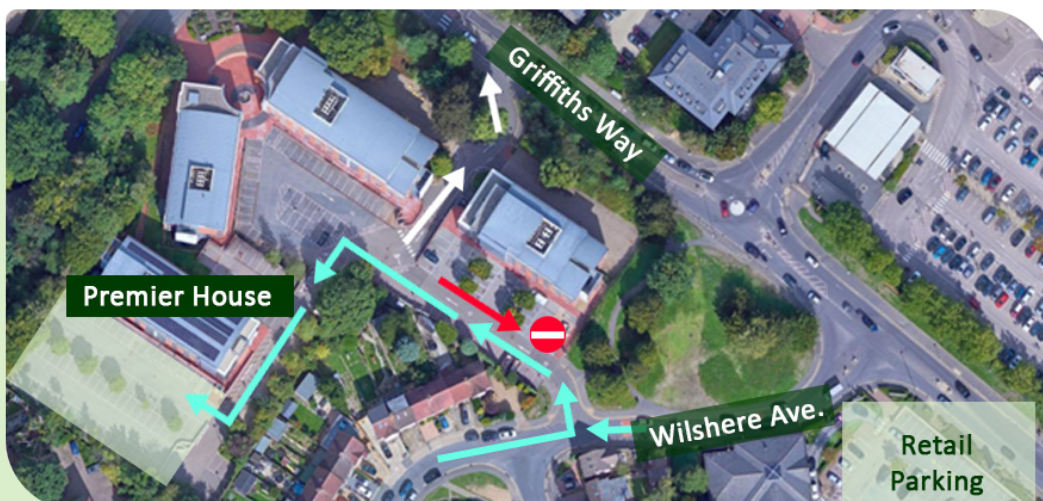
Car Parking at St Albans

Important notice – there are a number of parking bays that belong to neighbouring tenants which carry a £100 fine, Premier Foods colleagues and visitors should only use bays marked 'PF'.

Due to the limited availability of car parking spaces on the Centrium Business Park, priority is given to Premier Foods staff permanently based at St Albans, external visitors are welcome to use PF marked parking bays on site if available, the map below highlights the PF parking bays in green shading.

During busy periods, visiting Premier Foods staff and external contractors should use the Westminster Lodge car park. This is a Pay and Display car park, costing approx. £15.00 to park for one day. Payment can be made by cash or card. Note that there is a pedestrian exit on to St. Stephens Hill that provides the quickest route to the Centrium Business Park. Please take care when crossing the road.

Parking is available close by within the retail parks, but please note that these are restricted to 2 or 3 hour periods at a time, please check the signs carefully.



By Road

From M25 (Eastbound)

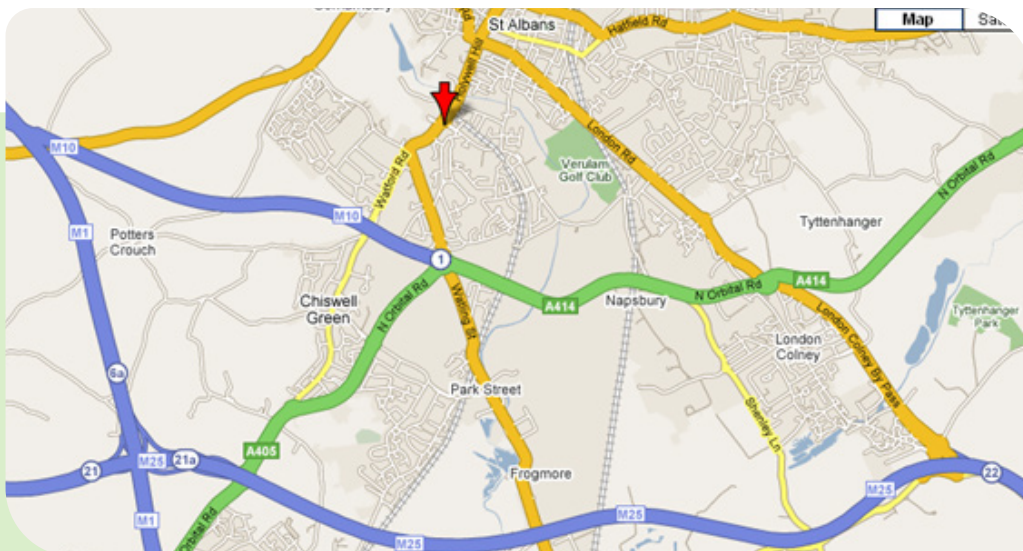
1. At junction 21a, exit toward St Albans on North Orbital Road (A405)
2. At the first roundabout take the 2nd exit to continue on the North Orbital Road (A405)
3. At the next roundabout (Park Street Roundabout) take the second exit onto Watling Street (A5183)
4. At the top of Watling Street, opposite the King Harry pub, turn right on the mini-roundabout onto Saint Stephens Hill
5. Turn right at the roundabout at the bottom of Saint Stephens Hill onto Griffiths Way
6. Take the first right onto Wilshire Avenue, then the first right again into the Centrium Business Park

From M25 (Westbound)

1. At junction 22, exit toward St Albans (A1081)
2. Turn right at the roundabout at the top of the exit slip lane.
3. At the first roundabout take the third exit onto London Colney Bypass (A1081)
4. At the next roundabout take the exit for the A414 towards Hemel Hempstead (North Orbital Road)
5. At the next roundabout (Park Street Roundabout) take the fourth exit onto Watling Street (A5183)
6. At the top of Watling Street, opposite the King Harry pub, turn right on the mini-roundabout onto Saint Stephens Hill
7. Turn right at the roundabout at the bottom of Saint Stephens Hill onto Griffiths Way
8. Take the first right onto Wilshire Avenue, then the first right again into the Centrium Business Park

From M1 (Southbound)

1. At junction 7, exit onto the M10 toward St Albans/Hatfield
2. At the first roundabout (Park Street Roundabout) take the first exit onto Watling St (A5183) heading to St Albans/A5183
3. At the top of Watling Street, opposite the King Harry pub, turn right on the mini-roundabout onto Saint Stephens Hill
4. Turn right at the roundabout at the bottom of Saint Stephens Hill onto Griffiths Way
5. Take the first right onto Wilshire Avenue, then the first right again into the Centrium Business Park
